

## WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD BRING TO CAMP?

**CLOTHING** – We want your children to have a wonderful summer, relax and partake in all camp activities. Their clothing should be comfortable and allow them to feel free to get dirty if necessary. (Camp is a good place to wear old clothing!)

Shorts, T-shirt, Bathing Suit, Towel, and Sneakers should be your camper's attire for the summer. Because of rugged terrain at camp, closed-toed shoes are required. Please, **NO SANDALS** – campers cannot run in them and they may hurt their toes! A sweatshirt or light jacket should also be in your camper's bags for cool mornings and unexpected weather. Pants are required for horseback riding.

**LUNCH** - Dairy sack lunch if bringing lunch from home. See page 6 for suggestions.

**WATER BOTTLE** – A reusable water bottle that can be refilled at camp is required. There are water fountains around the camp grounds for refills throughout the day.

**SUNSCREEN**– We require parents to apply sunscreen to their campers before coming to camp. Also, send a bottle of sunscreen to be reapplied during the day. Be sure to label everything with your child's name.

## LOST AND FOUND

Please label all clothing and belongings (including bags and shoes). We will make every attempt to return lost labeled clothing to the campers. The remaining items will be placed in a bin outside of *Squirrel Hall* where campers and parents can check regularly. Once the summer ends, unclaimed items will be donated.

We try our best to send everything home that comes to camp each day – however, it doesn't always happen. Many shorts, T-shirts, socks, shoes and bathing suits look alike so please take some extra time to **label all clothing and bags**. Permanent ink or nametags are preferred. Use the whole name, because many campers have the same initials. **Do not send your camper with valuable items**. Expensive sports equipment, money, toys, watches, jewelry, etc. can easily be lost. We want to avoid the disappointment that occurs when they lose special items. In order to create a magical camp experience, cell phones, radios, toys, playing cards, comic books and handheld electronic games are NOT permitted in camp.
